To notify the City Engineer/Code Enforcement Officer at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the commencement of the work proposed, and again at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the covering of any underground portions of the installation.

Obtaining the proper permits shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner or general or primary contractor and are required before beginning any work. Failure to obtain a proper permit will result in the following late charge fees added to the cost of the permit:

- 1. Failure to obtain a permit minimum late charge fee shall be \$100.00 for permits up to \$50.00.
- 2. Failure to obtain permit for any permits over \$50.01, the late charge fee shall DOUBLE the amount of the permit.
- 3. Failure to pick up and pay for permit within 10 days after issuance, a late charge fee of \$100.00 will be assessed.

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Do:

 Have your system inspected (in general) every three- years by a licensed contractor and have the tank pumped, when necessary, generally every three to five years.

Don't:

- Park or drive on your drainfield. The weight can damage the drain lines.
- Plant trees or shrubs too close to your drainfield, roots can grow into your system an.d clog it.

Do:

 Consult a septic service professional to advise you of the proper distance for planting trees and shrubs, depending on your septic tank location.

Planti Strain Your Draint

Don't

 Concentrate your water use by using your dishwasher, shower, washing machine, and toilet at the same time. Alf that extra water can really strain your septic system,

Do:

- Stagger the use of water-generating appliances. This can be helpful especially if your system has not been pumped in a long time.
- Become more <u>wate1 efficient</u> by fixing plumbing leaks and consider installing bathroom and kitchen faucet a.erators and water-efficient products.
